Interactive Sound Wall Project

I am proud and excited to show you the interactive sound wall that your organization helped so generously fund for Crestview Elementary School. The students love to "play" with their sounds. The wall is separated by Vowel Valley and Consonant Corner. The buttons are located above or below the sound card. The students can push the button to hear the correct sounds the letter (according to Orton Gillingham) makes while looking at the mouth placement, the letter, and a keyword. It is an excellent way for the students to quickly hear and identify the differences in the sounds through a multisensory approach to instruction that meets the needs of most students. It has proved to increase their test scores as the graphs indicate. This interactive sound wall will continue to help future students for years to come. 















ESTHER H. STRICKLAND STUDENT TEACHING GRANTS
